Eligibility: Any person who is employed as a dispensing optician and has passed the ABO, NCLE, or State Equivalent Examination and is in sympathy with the purposes and objectives of the Association shall be eligible for an Honored Fellow Membership provided such person is not a proprietor, partner or officer of an optical dispensing firm or practice. If you are a member of a state association that is a member of OAA, you are eligible for a Dual-Honored Fellow Membership. *Proprietors, partners and officers of Firm Members shall be eligible for Firm or Guild Membership(s).*
